Description and application: Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident with a minimum cumulative average of 85%. Up to 30 Loran Awards, valued at up to \$100 000 will be awarded. Loran will also grant up to 40 \$3000 finalist awards and 40 \$2000 provincial awards. There are 2 ways to apply: Sponsored Candidates and Direct Pool Candidates. Centennial can sponsor up to 3 candidates. If you wish to be considered for one of these spots, you must submit a rough copy of your application with a reference letter to the guidance office. Students must demonstrate academic excellence, leadership and/or financial need. Students should be entrepreneurial minded and pursuing a career in technology, innovation, engineering and scientific research. Not in consideration are students who: focus on activism, intend to become a practicing Physician or Medical Researcher, Nurse, Psychologist, Pharmacist, or Optometrist or intend to become a Professor and conduct theoretical research. In order to become a Schulich Leader and receive the scholarship, students must first be selected by their high school or Cégep as Schulich Leader Nominee.
